

Have it ALL after school this year!

+What is ALL?

Always Learning at Longfellow (ALL) is a fee-based, after-school enrichment program that offers affordable, educational classes to all Longfellow students. Each class begins after school dismissal and runs for 1 hour. ALL for the year 2022-2023 will have 3 sessions (a fall session, a winter session, and a spring session). For the Winter & Spring session the program will operate Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.



+ How does it work?

Parents receive the schedule along with registration information before the session begins and are able to sign up and pay online or by providing a check to the front office. When classes meet their maximum, parents will be able to add their child to a waitlist. Once the registration is closed, ALL members tally up the results and send out confirmation emails to the parents. Once the class begins, children will meet their instructors in the PKP hallway after dismissal, where attendance will be taken. The instructors then escort the kids to their class. Pick-up will be at 4:00 in the front entrance hallway (3:30 on Wednesday). We reserve the right to dismiss from the program (without a refund) children who are picked up late more than once or who are disruptive in class. No refunds will be given after the first week of classes.

+What else do I need to know?

If your child needs an after-school snack, feel free to send **a nut-free snack** along with your child. A limited number of need-based scholarships are available based on eligibility for free or reduced-fee lunch.

+2023 Winter ALL Session Schedule

Winter: 1/16 - 3/9 The program will run 8 weeks with no classes on Monday 1/16, Monday 2/20 and Thursday 2/9.

** Sessions may have additional off-days at the discretion of the school/D97, such as for in-service, conferences, inclement weather, or at-home learning days.

+ Stage Stars By Chess Scholars

Lights, Camera, Act- Does your child have a "dramatic side"? You might have a budding Stage Star in your family! Our drama class introduces students to the craft of stage acting with a skilled theater instructor. During this exciting class, students will learn theatrical skills, improv basics, and participate in interactive drama games. This class provides opportunities for students to have fun, express themselves, gain confidence, and interact with others, all within the context of theatre arts.

+Multi-Sport Madness: By Legacy Sports

Our most popular program includes variations of traditional gym games like relay races, tag, capture the flag, dodgeball, and soccer as well as our popular Legacy games like Hand Hockey, Illinois Jones and Battleship.

+Chess Club: by Deja Anderson, Longfellow teacher

This session provides students with the fundamentals of chess rules, strategies and good sportsmanship. The focus is on using higher-order thinking skills while having fun playing a great game.

+Board Game Club: by Mr. Sassetti, Longfellow Teacher

Here's a **CLUE**: there's a new after-school board game club. We can **CONNECT 4** kids so you won't have to **SCRABBLE** to find a group to play. **SORRY!** We won't be eating **CANDYLAND** or **APPLES TO APPLES**, but you can stay out of **TROUBLE** after school and have fun playing games!

+Yoga: Buddha Belly Kids Yoga

The primary focus of this course is to teach young children to develop self-regulation skills, along with self-awareness and self-mastery. This course includes themed practices that incorporate breath awareness, warm up, asanas (yoga poses), transition to quiet, meditation and relaxation, along with games, creative movement and activities that make yoga engaging, safe, and effective. Yoga mat required. Students may either provide their own or purchase a mat through ALL.

+ Giving Artfully

A program first piloted at Longfellow in 2014, the mission of Giving Artfully Kids is to help children make a difference by helping others through crafting. We believe that the process of creating is a valuable tool to teach kids about the concept of giving. It is our goal to inspire children to continue to give to others, in their own way, after they complete this program.

+Let's Code It!: By Chess Scholars

In this exciting new coding class from Afterschool Enrichment Solutions, students will take a deep dive into computer programming with the web-based platform Tynker! They will also learn the art of digital animation, create video games, design minecraft blocks, experiment with HTML, Java and Python.
